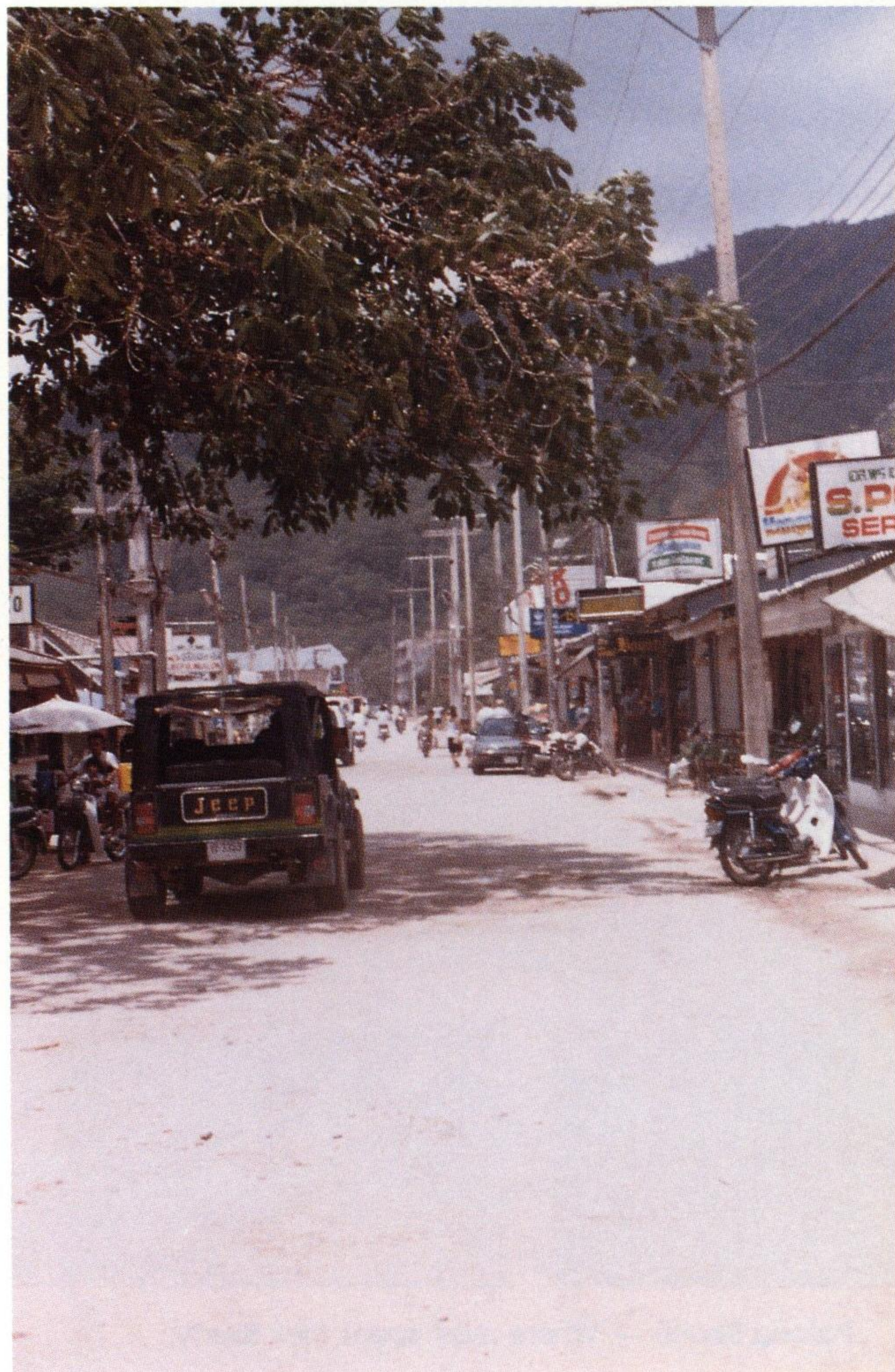


Phuket, Thailand
