Commander Green is a native of California and was educated in Ohio. Upon graduation from the U.S. Naval Academy in 1971, he was commissioned and served in **USS VOGE (DE-1047)** until 1974 as Gunnery Assistant, Damage Control Assistant and Antisubmarine Warfare Officer. He then attended the U.S. Naval Postgraduate School in Monterey, California and received the Master of Science degree (ASW Systems) in 1977. After completing the Surface Warfare Officer Department Head Course he served as Weapons Officer in **USS RICHARD L. PAGE (FFG-5)**, then as Operations Officer in **USS PREBLE (DDG-46)** until 1982. Subsequent duty

in the Special Operations Branch of Commander in Chief U.S. Atlantic Fleet Staff was followed by his assignment as Executive Officer in **USS DAHLG-REN (DDG-43)**. From 1985 to 1988 Commander Green served as Combat Systems and Tactics Instructor in the Prospective Commanding Officer Course at Newport, Rhode Island. He assumed command of **USS TAYLOR** on St. Patrick's Day in 1989.

Commander Green's personal awards include the Meritorious Service Medal with Gold Star, The Navy Commendation Medal and the Navy Achievement Medal.

He is married to the former Kate Donohue of Jenkintown, Pennsylvania. They have three children and reside in Summerville, South Carolina.
